

DIP AND DIVE

ENGLISH

We will be travelling around the world this term! To begin with, we will read 'Tad,' by Benji Davies. Then we will cover the life cycle of frogs using various non-fiction texts. After that, we will read 'The Snail and the Whale,' by Julia Donaldson. There will be lots of role-play this term and we will be developing our creative writing by using different genres. We will be making sure our sentences are complete and have correct punctuation. We will be encouraging the children to use a wider range of exciting vocabulary and to choose their words for effect.

MATHS

We will be covering several units this term. We will continue to count in 2s, 5s, and 10s as we introduce multiplication and division. This will lead us into finding a half and a quarter of shapes and numbers. After this, we will explore numbers to 100. This will involve comparing and partitioning numbers. Finally, we will focus on positional language, money and time.

HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY

In geography, we will be using language linked to maps to describe the position of landmarks. We will make our own maps of the school and include a key for the physical and human geographical features. In history, we will learn about Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong. We will compare their lives and discuss how they are similar.

SCIENCE

We will have a busy term! We will be learning about the different animal groups and their diets. We will identify some common animals and describe their basic features. We will plant seeds and watch them grow, observing the changes that occur. We will identify parts of flowers and trees. .

PE

This term we will begin to take part in team building games, including attack and defence. We will also develop our coordination, balance and agility.

MUSIC

We will be continuing our singing skills, learning a range of songs. We will be getting the musical instruments out and exploring the musical patterns we can make with them.

RE

We will be learning about the Pentecost story as part of our Christianity topic. We will also look at Jewish prayers and blessings this term.

EAS

We will discuss how to keep ourselves safe and what to do in an emergency. Towards the end of the term, we will take part in transition activities for next year.



COMPUTING

During the term, we will use ScratchJr and GarageBand to create our own repeating sound patterns.

ART & DESIGN

Our focus artist will be Monet. We will recreate one of his paintings from the famous 'Water Lilies' collection. .
