

## ENGLISH

Our core texts this term will be 'Who Let the Gods Out?' by Maz Evans and 'Greek Myths' by Marcia Williams.

Before we are transported back into the times of ancient Greece, we will explore what Greece is like today – and create a holiday brochure suitable for a tourist. We will then be using a range of non-fiction texts to choose an aspect of ancient Greece, which we will be writing a non-chronological report based on. Finally, we will be writing our own Greek myths.

## SCIENCE

During the first half of the term we will be studying 'Animals including Humans', which explores the different stages of the human life-cycle. The second half of the term will be looking at 'Living things and their habitats'. We will be describing the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will also describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

## PE

Striking and fielding games (Cricket and Rounders) will be the focus of our summer term P.E. We will be participating in a range of athletic activities: both track and field.

# MEET THE GREEKS



## E4S (Education for Safeguarding)

Pupils will identify how their bodies have changed since they were a baby and what has stayed the same and will learn what puberty is and about the physical and changes that happen during puberty. They will also learn what germs, bacteria and viruses are and about good hygiene routines.

## FRENCH

We will continue to expand our vocabulary while focusing on developing sentence structure and grammatical understanding through the topics of School life and clothing.

## MATHS

We will commence the term with geometry – exploring properties of shape and also studying position and direction. We will then be delving deeper into the use of decimals. Measurement will form the last unit of the term, looking at volume, mass and converting units.

## HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY

During this term, we are going to explore life in Ancient Greece and find out how the progressive thinkers of that period still influence our lives today. We will study how the physical geography of the area influenced the lives of Ancient Greeks.

## THE ARTS

Greek culture will inspire our work in Art and Design Technology including Greek vases. We will also be learning about the famous artist Alberto Giacometti and using his inspiration to create our own sculptures.

## RE

We will be looking at the significance of the Eucharist for Christians and within Buddhism we will investigate how Buddha taught his followers to find enlightenment.
